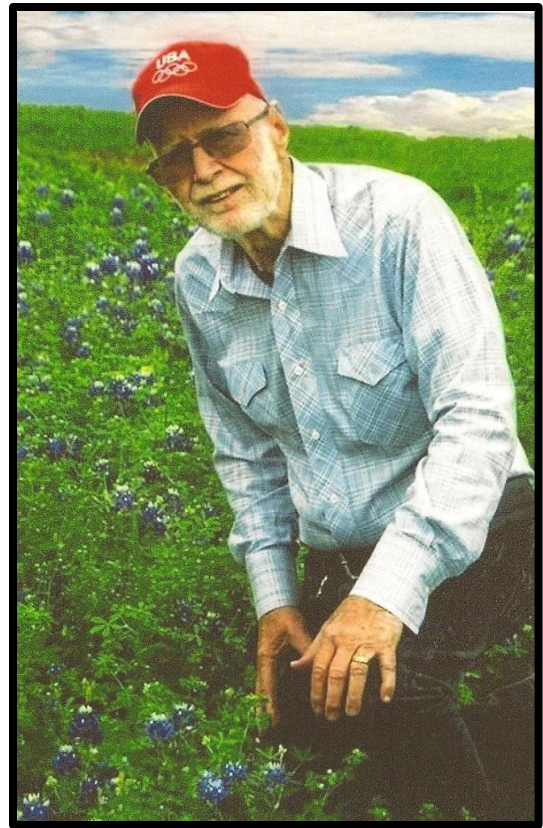

Jim Parks – LTTL Pioneer

**Zip-a-dee-doo-dah, zip-a-dee-ay
My, oh my, what a wonderful day
Plenty of sunshine headin' my way
Zip-a-dee-doo-dah, zip-a-dee-ay!**

These familiar lyrics along with the upbeat melody from one of Disney's epic motion pictures are universally acclaimed. Even so, this song is just a little bit unusual for the opening to a memorial service. But, Jim Parks was also unusual in many ways. The Lord took him home on April 22, 2016 at age 72 following a long battle with cancer. Jim is survived by his wife of 41 years, Glenda, and other family members. He was licensed as a minister by Sagemont Church.

Jim Parks was a pioneer in Less Than The Least (LTTL) Ministries along with Zeke Young (Founder), Grandma Alma, and the original Bar Hoppers. He has been involved in every phase of the ministry: Cell-to-cell visitation, preaching, PALs, newsletters, radio, photos, videos, office IT administration, and board of directors. Zeke remembers, "It was probably Grandma Alma who got Jim involved in Less Than The Least. But, Jim was truly called by God. He was a humble, called man of God with so many abilities. And, he was always available."



Jim planned his own memorial service which proved to be a source of great comfort to family and friends. Speakers expressed sentiments and memories of Jim that are shared by all who knew him:

- Fred Newton - "He was the most faithful, dedicated man I have run across. He loved sharing God's word." Remembering one cold, cold day at Coffield when he had reached the point of giving it up and going home, Fred said Jim responded, "Let's talk to one more, just one more."
- Bob Crites - "Jim was a giant of faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. He was bold with the living Word but quiet in his spirit. He would witness to anybody. Many people will be in heaven because of Jim Parks' witness. Pray that God will raise up others like Jim Parks. His eyes have become his faith; he sees Jesus and is in His presence."
- Buddy Griffin - "Jim knew how to care for and communicate with people. He was warm. He was a comfort to family and loved ones. The last time I talked to Jim on the phone he said, 'Buddy, I think I am going to heaven pretty soon.' Jesus is preparing a place; Jim has moved into his. And he would want me to tell you that Jesus is 'the way, and the truth, and the life.'

David Gunter summed it up well, "We have been blessed to know Jim Parks. It was tremendous to go into prison and minister with him. I could not have done my job as Director of LTTL without him."

Finally, this revealing tribute in a letter just received from a prison inmate at Ramsey says it all:

"Bro Jim Parks was a picture of God's love in action. He could have gone fishing or off playing golf or just chilling out at home. But NO! He took time out of his life to come to prison to visit a guy who is convicted of murder who doesn't deserve anything... I cannot even begin to express the impact that Bro Parks had on my life. The love of God that he shared with me, I must share it with others."

And after opening with "Zip-A-Dee-Doo-Dah", what closing song do you think Jim chose for his memorial service? "Turn Your Eyes Upon Jesus."

Stringfellow Revival July 8-10

Flood waters from the Brazos River forced the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) to evacuate the Stringfellow, Terrell, and Ramsey prison units near Rosharon during June. This action required the movement of more than 4,000 inmates. Nineteen LTTL ministry events over a three week period had to be cancelled. We have now resumed ministry at these units and are thankful for the success of this large operation. So far, all the Christian brothers that we serve and minister alongside and general population that we know about returned safely.

We are also thankful that our 3-day revival at the Stringfellow Unit can proceed as planned. Services are scheduled for July 8-10 at 6:30-8:30PM each night. Dr Brett Dutton, pastor of Magnolia Creek Baptist Church in League City and adjunct professor at Southwestern Baptist Seminary and Houston Baptist University, will do the preaching. David Gunter, Exec Director of LTTL, will lead in praise and worship accompanied by combined LTTL and Stringfellow bands. And, a relatively large group of LTTL volunteers and visitors will attend and provide testimonies and counseling.

Please pray for this effort. We know that “without Him we can do nothing.” So, pray that the Holy Spirit will work in the hearts of volunteers and visitors and those on the inside....for His glory alone. Pray that God’s Word delivered in preaching, singing, testimonies, and counseling will be used by the Holy Spirit to penetrate the hearts of those who do not know Him.

Get Involved With US

LTTL continues to be blessed with new volunteers who want to minister inside the walls. This includes speakers, worship leaders, ex-inmates, and people who want to counsel and visit one-on-one. For this we are encouraged and very thankful. But, we still have opportunities for service that really need to be filled. Please consider the following areas of service that minister to prison inmates but do not require going inside the walls. Ministry Coordination & Administration

Indigent Care Coordinator – Female inmates need some extra items for personal care (shampoo, deodorant, tooth paste, soap) while in prison. And some have no resources or family to provide for these needs. Working with the TDCJ Chaplains, LTTL does as much as possible to meet this need. Several volunteers have worked to make this happen along with our Exec Director, David Gunter (See the Dec 2015 newsletter on our web site for more details). But, we do need someone to lead our efforts to help these ladies who have no resources and no family support.

Youth Ministry Coordinator – LTTL has provided special programs for youth assemblies at schools, churches, community centers, and detention centers for several years. These assemblies have involved ex-inmate testimonies, sermons, and music by LTTL volunteers. We now have an opportunity to provide this ministry in

Harris County at four different youth centers. But, we must have someone to coordinate this activity which would include scheduling of events and volunteers and participating as possible.

Office Administration – In addition to Bible study leadership inside the walls, Marc Gentine volunteers two mornings per week in the LTTL Friendswood office on FM 518 helping our Exec Director complete the necessary office work associated with the ministry. Please consider volunteering to help in the office on one or more of the other three days. This work is necessary and touches many of our ministries to prison inmates.

Prayers and Letters (PALs)

When we go into prisons for worship services and Bible studies, blank forms are passed out for inmates to complete with their prayer request, name, and TDCJ number. About 40% of males complete these forms on average and about 80% of females. We then pass these prayer requests on to volunteers who pray for the inmates and follow-up with a card or letter. All correspondence goes through the LTTL address and volunteers only use first names (See the Feb 2014 newsletter on our web site for more details). This is a wonderful ministry of prayer and encouragement and we need more volunteers. Please consider this opportunity.

Study Bibles

For years now LTTL has provided Study Bibles free of charge to inmates who write asking for one. During 2015 we mailed 756 Study Bibles to inmates. And, we are on pace to mail almost 1,000 during 2016 if we have sufficient funds. Placing God’s Word in the hands of a prison inmate who asks for it means that we have made an investment with eternal impact in the life of someone that God is already touching (See the May 2014 newsletter on our web site for more details). But, we can only respond to inmates as we have funds (approx \$15/Study Bible including postage). Please consider making a contribution designated for Study Bibles.
